Notice of Availability for the Multifamily Housing Program

The California Department of Housing and Community Development is pleased to announce the release of the January 2020 Multifamily Housing Program (MHP) **Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA)** for approximately \$297 million.

This January 2020 MHP NOFA is funded from Proposition 1 - the Veterans and Affordable Housing Bond Act of 2018 - which California voters approved on November 6, 2018, authorizing bonds providing \$1.5 billion in new funding for housing. This funding will assist with new construction of affordable homes and acquisition, rehabilitation, and preservation of permanent and transitional rental housing for lower-income households.

The Universal and Supplemental Applications will be released soon.

Applications are due Monday, March 2, 2020
