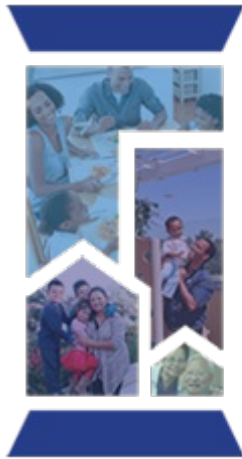

Fair Housing Training: Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)

Organizations that have received federal funding to finance the development, new construction, rehabilitation, administration, or management of affordable housing are subject to the requirements in these statutes. If you have received CDBG, HOME, Project-Based Section 8, Transit-Oriented Development, Rapid Rehousing, HOPWA, Continuum of Care, ESG, Housing Trust Fund, American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, Neighborhood Stabilization Program or any other type of federal financial assistance from or through the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD), there are specific fair housing obligations under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, and the Americans with Disabilities Act that every recipient of federal housing dollars should know. Preeminent fair housing experts will convene to provide an interactive training on these important matters.
