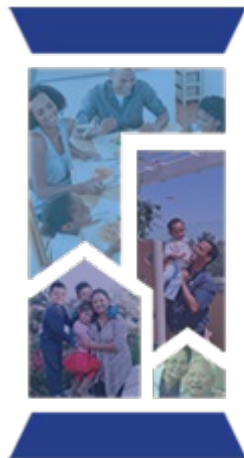

# Land Development Code Update Community Workshops

The County of San Diego Planning & Development Services (PDS) invites you to come learn about the Land Development Code Update (LDC or Code) and provide your input at upcoming community workshops in November. We want to hear from you!

The November/December workshops are the second of five rounds of community workshops planned for the LDC Update. The primary focus of the second round of workshops is to gather feedback on current Zoning Ordinance standards to help inform future draft revision of those standards. Revising the current Zoning Ordinance will strengthen implementation of the County's General and Community Plans. Draft revised Zoning Ordinance standards will be presented to the community for feedback at future community workshops. The second round of workshops include the following:
